Capital Grant Scheme 2025

Ynni Cymru's Capital Grant Scheme is now live and open for applications.

Ynni Cymru supports community-owned renewable energy and Smart Local Energy Systems (SLES). They have created a £10 million capital grant funding programme. Public and community sector organisations, and small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) looking to develop SLES in Wales can apply for funding.

Funding Available for Community-led projects between £25,000 – £150,000.

You can apply for up to £25,000 to improve your clubhouse or changing rooms and reduce your running costs
