<u>Asda Foodbank</u> Fundamentals Fund

This Fund is specifically for organisations whose core purpose is to distribute food and alleviate food poverty in their local community.

In response to ongoing cost-of-living challenges and high demand for foodbanks and food providers, this grant helps to cover their essential needs. Eligibility does not allow public bodies to apply though this is an opportunity for partnership working – please share this information.

offers grants to organisations and causes that provide transformational changes in communities in Wales.

Grassroots Pride Fund and Equality and Inclusion Grants for 2025-2026.

The Grassroots Pride Fund has helped for the last three years to put on Pride events the length and breadth of Wales to engage and support LGBTQ+ people and broader communities.

Regional Opportunities

Cwm Taf Community Cohesion Fund

The Cwm Taf Community Cohesion Team have small grant funding available (up to £2000) to develop projects which help bring communities together safely, ensuring groups can access initiatives that promote cohesive communities

New Grant Scheme to Tackle Food Inequality in the Vale of Glamorgan

Food, Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Grant £2500 for projects that ensure that all members of the community have access to healthy, affordable, and culturally relevant food.

Vale of Glamorgan Warm Spaces grant and Improving Access to Food grant

Aims to help communities tackle food insecurity by supporting projects that improve access to healthy, nutritious food and offer a safe place for people to gather, socialise, and access support services, reducing social isolation and addressing community concerns.

DLL Community Grant Scheme

will give smaller organisations and clubs in Denbighshire the opportunity to apply for capital money to support local events and activities related to arts and sport.



GRANTS & FUNDING POTENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES

Network Rail Tree Planting Fund

Grants of between £2,500 and £10,000 are available through the Network Rail Community Tree Planting Fund.

Branching Out Fund

Grants of between £250 and £2,500 are available to support a new season of community tree planting

Nature Save Trust

Funding includes nature conservation, sustainable communities (community growing projects to organisations specialising in recycling and repair) and renewable Energy.

National Lottery Heritage Fund - Nature Networks Fund

Awarding grants from £50,000 to £1million, this fund aims to strengthen the resilience of Wales' network of protected land and marine sites and build organisations' capacity to accelerate nature's recovery and engage communities.

Community Warm Spaces Fund

The Welsh Government funding for Warm Spaces will soon be distributed across local areas to support community initiatives during the colder months. Your Local Authority or CVC will be making this available soon.

Organisations in Wales can now apply to the <u>Adult Learners' Week</u> <u>Innovation Fund.</u>

The fund aims to support the creation of free bitesize taster sessions, learning events, outreach activity, masterclasses, learner voice or family learning led activities

Little Lives UK

Ending technology poverty through the donation of computers, tablets, and other electronics. by providing technology donations to schools, youth clubs, charities, and other organisations that work closely with children across the UK.
