



Hendy Nature Reserve


A project to create and enhance a recovering marshy grassland next to a SSSI and create a community garden for local volunteers. Started: October March 2024 Completed: March 2025






Hendy, Carmarthenshire

The village is dominated by the M4 and the floodplains of the Loughor and Gwili rivers. It started as a place to house workers from a nearby Tinplate Works. The population is 3,200 and 38% are Welsh speakers. The Council has an annual precept of £498,000 and covers the villages of Hendy, Tycroes and Llanedi.


