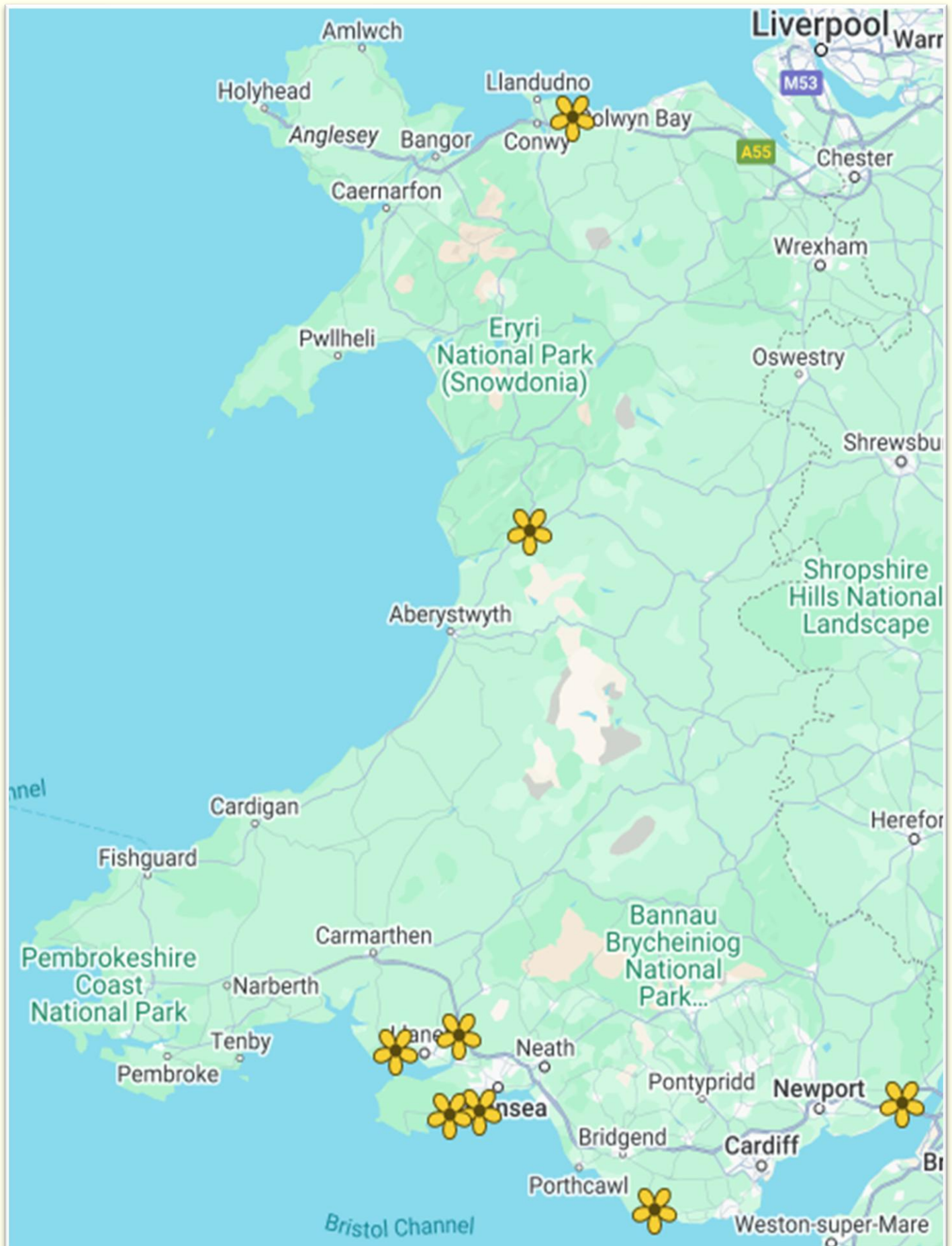

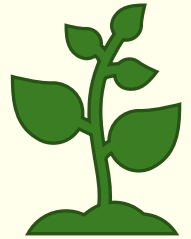

Hendy, Carmarthenshire

The village is dominated by the M4 and the floodplains of the Loughor and Gwili rivers. It started as a place to house workers from a nearby Tinsplate Works. The population is 3,200 and 38% are Welsh speakers. The Council has an annual precept of £498,000 and covers the villages of Hendy, Tycroes and Llanedi.

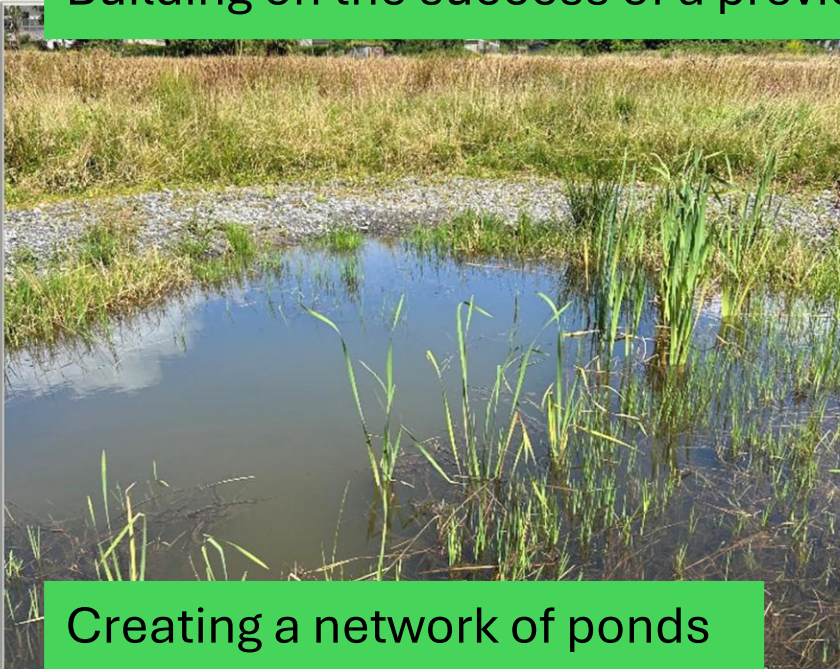

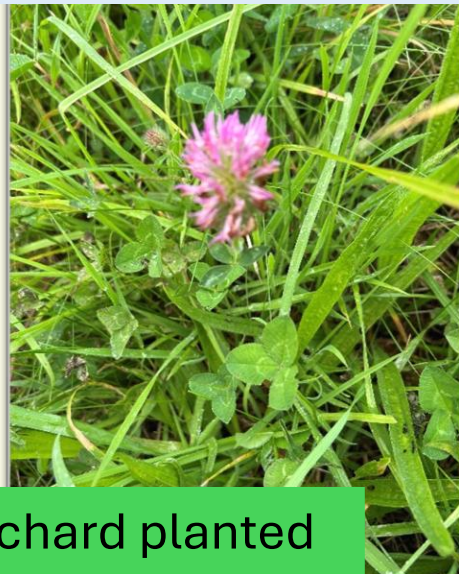
