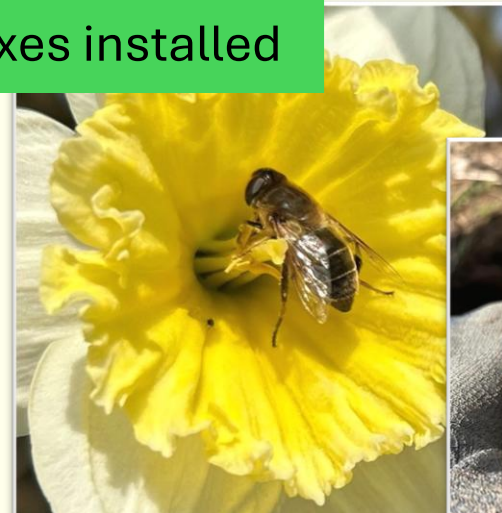

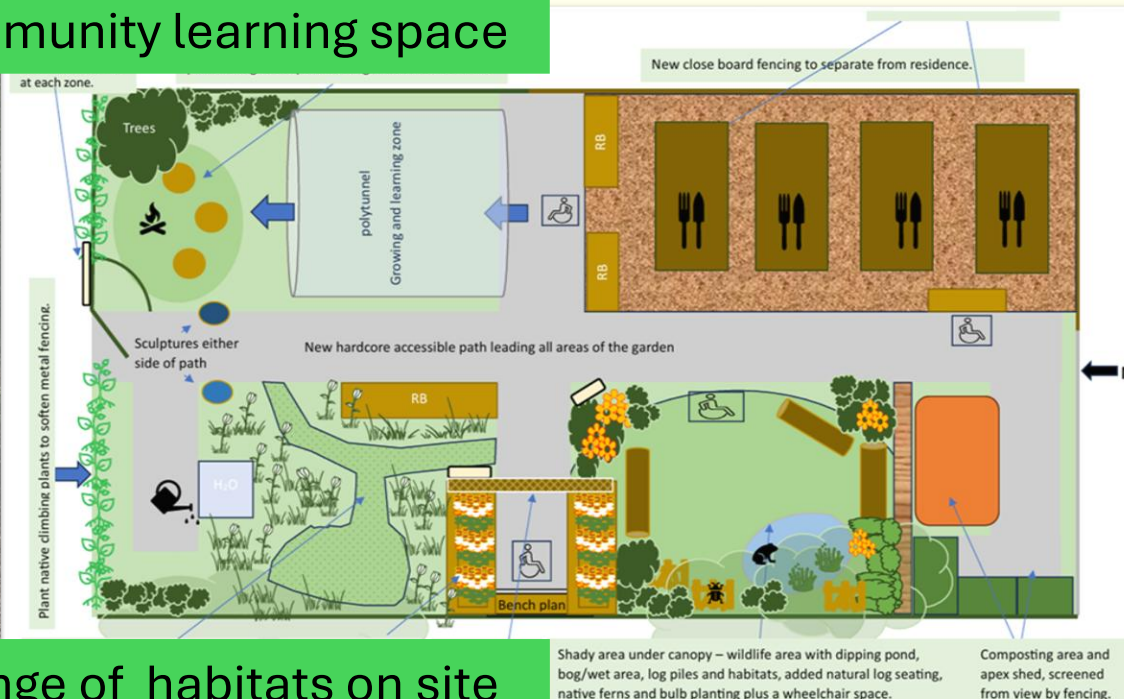
A project to create a community garden with food growing, community learning space, wetland area, native orchard and sensory garden. Started: June 2024 Due to complete: May 2025
