PONTARDDULAIS LEAD THE WAY

Pontarddulais Town Council Introduces Mandatory Training for Councillors Pontarddulais, Swansea - November 2025

Pontarddulais Town Council has taken a proactive step to strengthen local governance by **requiring all councillors to complete six One Voice Wales training modules** within their first year of office and at the start of each new term.

The motion, now part of the Council's Standing Orders, covers modules on *The Council, The Councillor, The Council Meeting, Introduction to Local Government Finance, Code of Conduct,* and *Equality and Diversity.*

Town Clerk Susan Rodaway said the idea came from hearing the phrase "training should be mandatory" across Wales. "It was time to turn that sentiment into action," she said.

The motion passed unanimously, with **Mayor Cllr. Philip Downing** praising it as a step toward stronger, more informed leadership:

"Well-informed councillors are the cornerstone of a thriving community."

The Council hopes its example will encourage other local authorities to follow suit, supporting Wales's wider goals of improving local democracy and public trust.

As you may be aware, Ystadau Cymru established a building safety group in 2024 to address the various challenges encountered by public estate managers throughout Wales.

As part of this initiative, the group has commenced an investigation into the risks associated with EV charging and lithium battery management, forming a dedicated sub-group of experts to lead this work. While comprehensive guidance is being developed, a temporary guide has been created to ensure timely awareness (please find attached).

Estate managers are advised to review the document and address any outstanding issues. By implementing appropriate safety measures, risks associated with EV charging or lithium batteries can be effectively managed.

Wales Regional Energy Strategic Plans (RESP)

The National Energy System Operator (NESO) is developing a bespoke regional energy strategic plan (RESP) for Wales. The plan will help to ensure Wales gets the energy infrastructure it needs to meet goals for economic growth and decarbonisation. NESO have developed a proposed methodology, setting out how the plan will be produced. The methodology was published for consultation on 17 November 2025 and runs until 16 January 2026.
