



GRANTS & FUNDING POTENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES

Welsh Government Perthyn Grant Scheme:

Up to £10,000 revenue funding to support with start-up fees during the early stages of developing social enterprises, co-operatives, community-led housing or community land trusts through the medium of Welsh. Groups will need to demonstrate the Welsh language is central to their initiative and future delivery.

Deadline 21st November.

The Fund for Wales is open to small, local, community led constituted charities and voluntary organisations, with grants of between £500 – £2,000 per annum for up to 3 years. **Deadline 1st December.** For more information: <https://communityfoundationwales.org.uk/grants/fund-for-wales/>

Meithrin Natur

National Lottery Community Fund
National Lottery Meithrin Natur is a £10 million fund available to help children in Wales access the natural environment. Motability Foundation Better Access to Active Travel Experiences & Equipment

Grants ranging from £50,000 to £1 million over up to three years are available to improve active travel options for disabled people. Funding can support projects with immediate or long-term impact, including equipment hire, grant programmes, support services, training, and pilot initiatives to test new models or solutions. **Applications close 15th December**

Regional Opportunities

Sustainable Development Fund Pembrokeshire

Fund supporting community projects in and around the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park with an aim to reduce local carbon emissions in the environment and to respond to the climate emergency.

Rhyl Flats Offshore Wind Farm,

Funding available for community projects across parts of the North Wales coastline. The fund is open for grant applications from £2,000 up to £10,000.

Arts, Health and Wellbeing Lottery Funding

The aim of this programme is to support partnerships from across the arts, health, social care and third sectors to provide high-quality creative projects that deliver health and wellbeing benefits for the people of Wales

- Nature – connection with nature through the arts;
- Mental health – build resilience and support better mental health;
- Health inequalities – address health inequalities
- Physical health and wellbeing – support improved physical health

The next funding round opens on Wednesday 19 November 2025 and will close at 1pm on Wednesday 21 January 2026.

Moondance Foundation

Moondance supports organisations that have a transformational impact in their communities in Wales. To prevent or relieve poverty, support the welfare and well-being of women, children, the older people and the vulnerable in our society, improve health outcomes, raise educational standards and preserve the environment for future generations.

Community Facilities Programme

a capital grant scheme operated by the Welsh Government, grants are available at two levels; small grants of under £25,000 and larger grants of up to £300,000.
