## **Job Opportunity: Clerk & Responsible Financial Officer**

Higher Kinnerton Community Council are seeking an organised, community-minded Clerk & RFO to support a friendly group of Councillors and help the Council run smoothly for the people of Higher Kinnerton.

### **Role Overview**

The role involves administering the Council's operations and finances and ensuring compliance with all legal, financial and administrative obligations. The Clerk, as the Proper Officer and RFO will be responsible for overseeing the execution of Council business, maintaining statutory responsibilities and representing the Council's interests.

Strong literacy, numeracy, organization, communication and IT skills are essential and previous experience in administration and financial management, ideally within a local government setting is desirable.

The successful applicant must be capable of working independently from home and will attend the Council's monthly evening meetings, normally held on the third Tuesday of each month (except in August) plus additional meetings as reasonably required.

### **Salary & Qualifications**

Remuneration will be based on NJC pay scales SCP 18 – 21 pro rata for 48 hours a month (£16.35 to £17.18 per hour) dependent on experience and qualifications. A workplace pension will be available if desired.
