


# Questions & Answers

## 1. How can I take part in Fix It February?

You can take part by:

- Pledging to repair at least one item during February.
- Visiting your local Repair Cafe to have something fixed.
- Sharing your repair journey on social media using the hashtag #FixItFeb

## 2. How do I find my nearest Repair Cafe?

You can find your nearest Repair Cafe by visiting the Repair Cafe Wales website: <https://repaircafewales.org/locations/>.

The map will show all active locations, their opening times, and contact details.

## 3. Do I need to book to attend a Repair Cafe?

No! Repair Cafes are drop-in events. Simply check the times and location of your nearest Repair Cafe and bring your item along on the day.

## 4. What kind of items can I bring to a Repair Cafe?

Repair Cafes typically accept:

- Clothing and textiles
- Small household electricals (e.g., kettles, toasters)
- Bicycles
- Toys and ornaments
- Small furniture
- Tech including, laptops, and tablets

Each Repair Cafe is unique, so check your local Repair Cafe's listing to confirm what they accept.

## 5. How much does it cost to attend a Repair Cafe?

Repair Cafes are free to attend. However, donations are always welcome to help cover the costs of running the events.

## 6. Who runs Repair Cafes?

Repair Cafes are run by dedicated volunteers from the local community. These volunteers may include skilled repairers, organisers, and helpers who contribute their time and expertise. Repair Cafe Wales provides support and resources to help these events thrive.

## 7. What if my item can't be repaired?

If your item can't be repaired, volunteers will offer advice on your options. This might include upcycling, repurposing, or recycling your item responsibly.

## 8. Why is repairing important?

Repairing items helps to:

- Reduce waste: Keeps items out of landfill.
- Save resources: Cuts down on the need for new manufacturing.
- Save money: Extends the life of your belongings.
- Fight climate change: Reduces carbon emissions associated with production and waste.
- Build community: Brings people together to share skills and knowledge.

## 9. I'm not very good at DIY or repairs—can I still participate?

Absolutely! Repair Cafes are the perfect place to learn. Volunteers are happy to show you how to repair your item or explain the process. You don't need any prior experience to attend.

## 10. How can my organisation support Fix It February?

Organisations can support Fix It February by:

- Sharing campaign content on their social media channels.
- Encouraging staff and customers to make repair pledges.
- Collaborating with Repair Cafe Wales to spread the repair message.

## 11. How can I volunteer at a Repair Cafe?

If you'd like to volunteer, reach out to your local Repair Cafe or contact Repair Cafe Wales for more information. Whether you're handy with a screwdriver, a sewing machine, or just want to help with tea and biscuits, there's a role for everyone!

While you wait, enjoy a cup of tea and a slice of cake before  
your turn with one of our talented fixing volunteers!
