Community and sports groups can apply for up to £50,000 of National Lottery funding for equipment and coaching courses.

Comic Relief Cwtch Communities Fund

Comic Relief Cwtch Communities offers small cwtches of support to Welsh voluntary organisations; a new grant scheme to help local organisations provide warm, safe, and caring support to the people who need it most.

Grants of **£15,000 to £35,000** are available to organisations delivering direct services and practical support within their communities.

Community and town councils are not eligible to apply directly for this Comic Relief funding, but we encourage you to share this opportunity widely with local groups and consider partnering with eligible organisations in your area to help access the funding.

Community Facilities Programme

This is a rolling programme of funding from Welsh Government. Whilst community and town councils are not eligible to apply applicants are expected to work with other organisations from the public, private or third sector. So while a council can't lead an application it can legitimately act as a public sector partner on a bid and play a valuable supporting role to improve facilities in their area.

The fund has been set up to improve the appearance, facilities and vibrancy of towns and villages across the county by supporting small, but high-impact improvements.

- improvements to community spaces,
- public space improvements,
- regeneration of town centres and the high street.

The Carmarthenshire Fund provides support to the following themes:

- projects that help people with poor mental health to build confidence and resilience to broaden their horizons
- projects that will work to improve and raise the aspirations of disadvantaged children and young people

Local community groups, charities and projects can apply for grants of between £500 and £2,000 a year for up to three years.

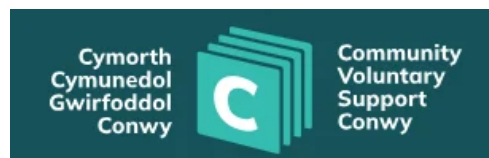


Flintshire Community Chest 2026/27

The fund provides grants to support community activity in Flintshire, with priority being given to smaller local organisations. Recent grants have been awarded for gardening tools, sports equipment, building repairs, defibrillators, marketing for new activities, amongst other things.

Applications are now being accepted from organisations benefiting people from Flintshire for a grant of up to £ 1000. Grants will only cover 75% of the total cost, so match funding is essential. Round 1 closes May 25th.
